


To estimate a travel budget, consider the expense categories below. Individual expenses may vary.

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FAQs

- 1. **Is child or dependent care provided?** We do not offer child or dependent care support at this time.
- 2. Are there other lodging alternatives nearby? We recommended that all conference attendees stay at the conference venue (El Conquistador) to facilitate logistics. Guests must check in at the main gate to enter the grounds, and the resort's security team may request booking details to enter the property.
- 3. **Do you provide tours or excursions?** We do not offer FDRS-organized tours or excursions. However, Puerto Rico is a premier tourist destination. We offer recommendations for agrifood tours and nearby attractions in East Puerto Rico. The conference venue also contains various amenities, including a pool, golf, tennis, spa, Coqui waterpark, and Palomino Island beach. In addition, the resort partners with <u>Saltours</u> (adventures@saltourspr.com) for tours across the island.
- 4. **Do you provide transportation to nearby attractions?** FDRS does not offer transportation to nearby attractions. For ground transportation, please get in touch with the resort concierge at Concierge@ConquistadorResort.com or (787) 863-1000 ext 6999. Saltours can also assist with taxi arrangements for their tours.
- 5. **Is the resort pet-friendly?** While they love animals, the resort only accepts ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) Certified Service Animals.
- 6. What is the resort cancellation policy under the group rate? The conference venue requires a deposit of one (1) night's room and tax to be charged upon reservation. There is a 72-hour cancellation policy to avoid penalty. If cancellation is required within 72-hours, one (1) night deposit plus tax will be forfeited. No-shows will forfeit one (1) night plus tax deposit. After arrival, guests departing earlier than reserved will be charged one (1) night room and applicable tax.
- 7. What is the conference registration cancellation policy? The conference registration is transferable. If the conference is canceled due to unavoidable or unforeseeable events, the conference registration minus any merchant fees charged by a third-party will be refunded.
